Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 67, dated 11.7.2019, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at P.S. Cheema, District Sangrur.

Allegations against petitioner are that 40 bottles of country made liquor of Haryana mark 'Shehnai' were recovered from the house of petitioner. However, petitioner ran away from the spot.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. No recovery has been effected from him.

Vide order dated 4.9.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Kishan Kumar, states that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 4.9.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
