This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 16.8.2019 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner for allowing them to complete the finishing/renovation work of the properties bearing SCO Nos. 135 & 136 situated in Shopping Centre, Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar.

On the oral request of learned counsel for the petitioners, Director, Local Bodies, Punjab is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.4.

Registry is directed to make the necessary amendment in the memo of parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 – Director, Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated

16.8.2019 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 – Director, Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 16.8.2019 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
