In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is against order dated 29.05.2015 (Annexure P-3), whereby, a punishment has been imposed upon the petitioner in respect of the charge-sheet dated 24.03.2015.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent states that without filing an appeal against the impugned order, petitioner has approached this Court by making an averment in para 20 of the writ petition that there is no remedy of appeal. Learned counsel for the respondent further states that there is a remedy of appeal before the Board of Directors against the order passed by the Managing Director and petitioner has not availed the same before approaching this Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner

states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the appellate authority against the order dated 29.05.2015 (Annexure P-3). Learned counsel further states that as the order was passed in the year 2015, the respondent might not entertain his appeal at this stage.

Learned counsel for the respondent assures that in case any appeal is preferred against the said order, the same will be decided on merits as the petitioner was pursuing the present remedy before this Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty, as prayed for.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved, he can approach the appropriate authority for redressal of his grievance as petitioner deems fit.
