Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

2. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned transfer order dated 31.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

3. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue his representation dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-8).

4. It would be appreciated that appropriate order is passed as expeditiously as possible.
