On 6.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.70, dated 31.07.2019, registered under
Sections 379/411 IPC, at Police Station D Division,
Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot and the
allegations against the petitioner are to the effect that he
along with the co-accused who was apprehended at the
spot with a stolen activa were going to sell the vehicle.
He submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion for 29.10.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender
Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the
State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr.

Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 6.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
