ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.198 dated 16.07.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 365, 506, 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was lodged on the basis of misunderstanding between the parties. Only simple injuries are stated to have been caused in the incident and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise deed which is at Annexure P-2. The petitioner is in custody for almost two months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh states that the challan is yet to be filed. He has filed the custody

certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 1 month and 23 days.

Ms. Neelam Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the matter has been compromised and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
