Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner states that the State of Punjab revised the pay of its employees in the year 2009 w.e.f. 01.01.2006 and the petitioners, who were working with the respondent-Punjab Tourism Development Corporation Limited, were also entitled for the grant of the benefit of the said revision w.e.f. 01.01.2006 as the Punjab Civil Services Rules have been duly adopted by the Punjab Tourism Development Corporation Limited. Learned Senior counsel argues that respondents were under obligation to revise the pay of the petitioners by granting them the benefit of revised pay scale as well as the consequential benefit of the revision of the pensionary benefits.

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners prays that a direction be issued to the respondent- Punjab Tourism Development Corporation Limited, to grant the said benefit of revision of pay w.e.f 01.01.2006 to the petitioners forthwith.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners further states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioners have served the respondents with demand notices dated 04.01.2019 and 23.01.2019(Annexure P-7 & P-8) respectively, which are still pending

consideration with respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage,

in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said demand notices.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to decide the demand notices dated 04.01.2019 and 23.01.2019 (Annexure P-7 & P-8) respectively, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
