Prayer in this application is for condoning delay of 5 days in filing the appeal.

Heard.

In view of averments made in the application supported by an affidavit and arguments addressed, the application is allowed and delay of 5 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

Main case

The minor injured is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injury sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 18.02.2012.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.95,187.00, detailed hereunder:-

Expenses incurred on treatment	Rs.25,187.00
Compensation on account of hospitalization	Rs.25,000.00

Compensation on account of pain and suffering	Rs.35,000.00
Compensation on account of loss of studies	Rs.10,000.00

I have gone through findings of the Tribunal on issue No. 2 with regard to grant of compensation under various heads. The injured remained admitted in Arora Hospital, Hisar from 18.03.2013 to 29.03.2013 i.e. for twelve days. Taking into consideration the materials on record and compensation assessed by the Tribunal under various heads, it is difficult to accept contention of the appellant that amount awarded by the Tribunal is not just and reasonable or there is justification for allowing additional amount over and above what has been allowed by the Tribunal. That being so, the appeal filed by the claimant is not meritorious and is liable to be rejected.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal is dismissed without any order as to costs.
