Learned counsel for the petitioner having produced in Court today an order passed by this Court on 13.03.2019, in CRM-M-11494-2019, upon the petitioner having sought the concession of anticipatory bail after he was summoned under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. in another criminal case registered against him, he seeks further time to produce in Court evidence to show that the petitioners' mother was ill, leading to him not being present in the Court on 29.08.2019, i.e. after interim bail was granted to him till 01.05.2019, vide the aforesaid order.

He further submits that there were also earlier a chance of a compromise being entered into between the parties, and that he was only absent on a one single date and therefore, with him not wanting to avoid facing trial, this petition should be allowed.

However, it is not denied that even prior to filing the application before the learned Sessions Judge under Section 438 Cr.P.C., he had remained absent before the trial Court on three dates.

Hence, I see no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed.

Even so, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court, and moving an application under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C, that would be decided very expeditiously by that Court, on its own merits.
