The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0223 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 379-B and 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sector-53, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that three persons had snatched a bag containing about Rs.6,50,000/- from the complainant. One of the accused picked up pistol from the dashboard of the car and hit it on the head of the complainant and thereafter, they fled away from the spot. Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner, who is 25 years of age, is in custody for over six months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel contends that 02 out of 11 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He also contends that recovery of Rs.50,000/- has been effected from the petitioner and the pistol has been recovered from another co-accused. He also contends that the petitioner was duly identified in the Test Identification Parade.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 06 months, he is 25 years of age, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
