Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.66
dated 04.06.2019 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code at
Police Station City-II Mansa, District Mansa.

On 20.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner
as well as the learned State counsel, this Court is of the view
that petitioner should be directed to join investigation.*

Notice of motion.

*On asking of the Court, Mr.S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. A.G.,
Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A
copy of the paper book be handed over to the learned State
counsel during course of the day.*

Adjourned to 20.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner

shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhcharn Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 20.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
