Petitioner-Sharanjit Kaur prays for regular bail in FIR No.140, dated 15.07.2019 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station – Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that her daughter and son of deceased were married on 07th March, 2007. Husband of Sharanjit Kaur had lodged a complaint dated 21st February, 2019, due to matrimonial discord. Daljit Singh, father of the son-in-law of the petitioner committed suicide on 15th July, 2019. In the alleged suicide note, the reason for suicide is harassment by the family of daughter-in-law.

Petitioner is in custody since 19th July, 2019. It is undisputed that the Investigating agency did not seek even one day remand of the petitioner. Therefore, petitioner is in judicial custody.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts this Court is of the considered view that further incorporation of the petitioner at this stage would not be justified. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, liberty is granted to the victim/first informant to move an application for cancellation before the learned trial court if in future there is such attempt.
