On 06.09.2019, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ *Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 0180 dated 08.08.2019 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.*

Notice of motion for 22.10.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

Mr. A.P.S.Sandhu, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall

abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instruction from ASI Kanwaljit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

Hence, the order dated 06.09.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
