The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 66 dated 31.7.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act), at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

Pursuant to the previous orders, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of ASI Amandeep Singh, SHO Police Station Mehta, Amritsar (Rural), which is taken on record.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted by the police official Ajay Pal Singh. Even as per the case of the prosecution, the recovery effected from the petitioner is 260 grams of intoxicant powder, containing the prohibited substance tramadol. The FSL report has found the prohibited substance tramadol 6.82% in the recovered material, which is much less than the commercial quantity. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 31.8.2019. Challan has already been filed.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Ajay Pal Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in heinous crime. However, she has not disputed that the petitioner had been in custody since 31.8.2018 till she was released on interim bail and that the challan has already been filed in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 11.9.2019 is made absolute.
