In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the adhoc service of the petitioner rendered from 13.05.1988 till 31.01.1996, should be taken into account as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits in view of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kesar Chand vs. State of Punjab and others, AIR, 1988, Punjab, 265.**

Counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner will be satisfied in case, the respondents are directed to decide the demand notice which the petitioner has served upon the respondents on 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) in this regard in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate order on the demand notice dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the said deemed notice, the same should also be released to him within three months thereafter.
