REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 10.02.2010.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.4,49,164/- (rounded off to Rs.4,50,000 /-), detailed hereunder:-

Reimbursement of medical expenses	Rs.3,14,164/-
Hospitalisation and healthy diet	Rs.30,000/-
Pain and sufferings	Rs.45,000/-
Transportation	Rs.15,000/-
Expenses for future treatment	Rs.20,000/-
For fracture	Rs.15,000/-
Future aspect	Rs.10,000/-

I have gone through the award passed by the Tribunal and find it interesting that the Tribunal has even allowed compensation under certain heads which are not heard of. The Tribunal has shown magnanimity in awarding compensation under various additional heads. There is no justification for allowing compensation more than what has been assessed by the Tribunal.

For the foregoing reasons, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed. As the appeal has been decided on merits, applications for condonation of delay are of academic relevance.
