All the aforementioned petitions have been filed under Section

438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.102 dated 14.08.2019 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 306 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sushil Kumar submits that petitioners have joined the investigation, which is still in progress but their custodial interrogation is not required for the purpose of further investigation.

In view of submission of learned State counsel but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, all these petitions are allowed. Orders dated 06.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-37570-2019; 11.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-38622-2019; and 26.09.2019 in CRM-M-41440-2019 are made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court;
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on presentation of challan in Court.
