ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.244, dated 27.12.2018, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the prosecution case, petitioner was found in possession of 12 injections of 2ML each of Buprenorphine rexogesic and 50 gram charas.

It is undisputed that 50 gram charas does not fall in commercial quantity. Petitioner is in custody since 27.12.2018. Investigations are complete and challan has been presented. Petitioner as per counsel for the State is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 27.12.2018 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
