Petitioner-Sushil Kumar has prayed for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.629 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 added later on) at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties have entered into a compromise and they have agreed to executed the sale deed in favour of the complainant on or before 15.11.2019.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the investigation the case is complete and the final report has been filed before

the competent Court of jurisdiction on 19.10.2019.

Considering the above and the fact that the offences are triable by Magistrate and trial of the case is likely to consume considerable time therefore, further custody may not be justified. Resultantly, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.

The petition is allowed.
