Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.195 dated 27.06.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa, District Sirsa.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.09.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the son of the petitioner, namely Gurpreet Singh, caused injury with Kappa on the right hand of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-accused Gurpreet Singh already stands arrested and the petitioner

is an old lady and only allegation against her is that she caught hold of complainant-Asha Singh by his hair...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Radhey Shyam, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
