Petitioner submits that sale-deed dated 08.06.2018 was executed by one Jaswant Singh in favour of the petitioner before the Sub Registrar, Ludhiana pertaining to a plot measuring 200 sq.yards. On account of a dispute having arisen, petitioner even instituted a suit for permanent injunction against respondent No.4 and which is pending before the Trial Court.

It is alleged that private respondents No.4 and 5 are hand in glove with respondent No.3 i.e. Incharge Crime Investigation Agency-II, Ludhiana and at the instance of private respondents No.4 and 5, respondent No.3 is harassing the petitioner and is repeatedly summoning him to his office.

The categorical submission made is that till date there is no criminal complaint/FIR against the petitioner.

In view of short grievance noticed hereinabove and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition as also submissions advanced by counsel, I deem it appropriate to dispose of

the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.2, as regards his grievance.

In the eventuality of any such application, being submitted, respondent No.2, would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
