AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that the application for appointment on compassionate ground filed by respondent No.2 has been decided and he has been placed at Sr. No.18.

Para 7 of the order dated 24.10.2016 passed by the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, reads as follows:-

“7. In view of the above discussion, it is held that the impugned order is hereby set aside. It is held that the appellant shall not be dispossessed from the official quarter subject to payment of rent/user charges at the rate as was being paid by the deceased employee till the appellant's turn reaches for appointment on compassionate ground or till the period of one year whichever is earlier, thereafter if the necessity arises,

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fresh order may be passed. The appeal is allowed accordingly. Memo of costs be prepared accordingly. Copy of judgment be sent to concerned quarter. Appeal file be consigned to records.”

In the light of the above order and the fact that the application for appointment on compassionate ground filed by respondent No.2 has been decided, the present writ petition does not survive any further.

Disposed of as infructuous.
