The petitioner prays for concession of regular bail in FIR No.0101 dated 17.04.2019, registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 120B IPC and 25 of Arms Act, 1950, at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arrested subsequently on the basis of some information and he is in custody since 10.05.2019. Investigation is complete and challan has been presented. The petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submitted that .12 bore pistol with 2 life cartridges and Rs.5,000/- have been recovered on the identification of the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and after keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to be release on regular bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/

Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
