By this common order, the afore-mentioned three writ petitions bearing CWP Nos. 6200, 13008 and 17673 of 2018 are being disposed of as common question of law on similar facts has been raised in the afore-mentioned writ petitions.

In the present writ petitions, the claim of the petitioner is for the release of the retiral and other benefits for which they are entitled for in respect of service rendered by them alongwith interest in view of law laid down by this Court in CWP No. 15306 of 2016 titled as “Hari Ram and others vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala” decided on 04.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the question of law which has been raised in the present writ petitions has already been answered by this Court in CWP No. 15306 of 2016 titled as “Hari Ram and others vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala” and other connected cases, decided on 04.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the respondent very fairly states that though no reply has been filed to the writ petitions, but the present writ petitions can be disposed of in terms of CWP No. 15306 of 2016 titled as “Hari Ram and others vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala” decided on 04.09.2017 as the question of law raised in these petitions already stands answered by this Court. Counsel further states that he already has instructions in this regard from the respondent.

Keeping in view the joint request made by learned counsel for the parties, all the three afore-mentioned writ petitions are disposed of in terms of order passed by this Court in CWP No. 15306 of 2016 titled as “Hari Ram and others vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala” on 04.09.2017.
