On 05.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are representatives of Retico Credit Rating Agency Private Limited and their job is only to submit verification report after verifying that whether loanee resides or works at the address given. She further submits that loan was disbursed on 24.03.2017 whereas verification report is dated 30.03.2017.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on

behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 17.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjit Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 5.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
