GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.0073 dated 15.04.2019, registered at Police Station Women, District Panipat under Sections 323, 498-A, 354, 376, 511, 406 and 506 of IPC.
2. The petitioner happens to be brother-in-law (*jeth*) of the complainant and the allegations levelled against him are that he had attempted to commit rape upon the complainant.
3. The learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner has been behind bars for the last about 7 months and although charges have been framed, but till date not even a single PW has been examined.
4. I have considered rival submissions addressed before this Court.
5. Bearing in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and that the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose, who has already been behind bars for the last about 7 months. The petition, as such, is

accepted and it is ordered that petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
