The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 24.05.2015.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.1,00,000/- i.e. Rs.82,960/- medical expenses and Rs.14,000/- for non-performing court work and insurance work.

Perusal of the award would reveal that the claimant produced on record documents mark A5 to A43. He did not examine any doctor to corroborate his plea that he was advised bed rest. Counsel for the appellant, in response to a query, would fairly inform that the claimant was discharged from the hospital the day he sustained injuries. In the given circumstances, there is no justification for allowing additional compensation.

For the foregoing reasons, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.
