The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Shakuntla in a motor vehicular accident that took place in the intervening night of 27/28.07.2012.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.1,41,951/- (rounded off to Rs.1,42,000/-), detailed hereunder:-

Loss of love and affection,	Rs.1,00,000/-
Loss of estate and loss of earning	
Medical expenses	Rs.11,951/-
Transportation and funeral expenses	Rs.30,000/-

As per postmortem report, the deceased was 85 years old. The plea of claimants that she was earning Rs.4000/- while preparing the dolls does not find corroboration from an independent source. In the given scenario, compensation allowed by the Tribunal to the extent of Rs.1,30,000/- qua death of the deceased besides medical expenses is much more, thus, cannot be said to be inadequate requiring enhancement.

In view of what has been discussed hereinbefore, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.
