

Rajiv Kumar Vs. Devi Dass @ Kala and others

On 01.05.2019, on behalf of the appellant statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Accordingly, ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case subject to all just exceptions with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in the name of the appellant Rajiv Kumar son of Sh. Om Parkash with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.07.2019 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
