This revision petition has been filed against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, while deciding complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881. The appeal against the judgment of conviction was also dismissed.

The petitioner has already undergone sentence of 1½ months approximately. During the pendency of the present petition, parties have entered into a settlement, copy whereof has been filed as Annexure P-2 along with CRM-30149-2019. The application (CRM-30152-2019) for compounding of the offence under Section 147 of the Act of 1881 has also been filed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent admits that the settlement has been arrived at and respondent has no objection if the offence is permitted to be compounded. Hence, compounding of the offence is allowed, in view of the settlement. The petitioner be released forthwith.

Petition stands allowed.
