The petitioner in this case sought a direction to the Haryana Electronics Development Corporation, Chandigarh, to regularize his services in the cadre of Data Entry Operator from the date of his entitlement.

By order dated 18.12.2018 passed in this writ petition, this Court directed the respondent Corporation to consider the case of the petitioner again, keeping in view certain case law and after giving him the benefit of continuous service. The respondent Corporation was required to pass a fresh order before the next date of hearing, viz, 24.04.2019.

Mr. Pankaj Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the respondent, would inform this Court that in compliance with the

aforestated order, the respondent Corporation issued a Speaking Order dated 23.04.2019, wherein reference was made to the earlier Office Order dated 07.12.2018, whereby the petitioner was stated to have been regularized in service in the post of Data Entry Operator in the correct pay band of ₹5200-20200 (PB-1)+GP ₹2400/- with effect from 30.06.2014. The order further records that no junior employee was promoted in this manner and no injustice was done to the interest of the petitioner. On this basis, the Chairman of the respondent Corporation concluded that no further benefits were payable to the petitioner.

A copy of the said order is supplied to Mr.Jangjit Singh Dahiya, learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the light of the aforestated development, the cause in this writ petition, as framed, no longer survives for consideration on merits. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of, leaving it open to the petitioner to seek redressal of his grievance, if any, with the Speaking Order dated 24.04.2019 issued by the respondent Corporation by way of separate proceedings in accordance with law.
