Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.95 dated 31.07.2018 registered under Sections 302, 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the FIR, petitioner Nirmal Singh @ Bhola along with his son Balwinder Singh only attributed the leg blow to the son of the complainant and he further states that seven members of the same family were arrested in the present case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh assisted by learned counsel for the complainant states that he does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has only attributed the leg blow but has stated that now the complainant is to be examined on 6th January, 2019 and out of 17 witnesses, already 03 witnesses have been examined.

It is the case in which the petitioner has only been attributed leg blow and he is in custody since 31st July, 2018. The trial would take time to conclude.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
