B.S. WALIA, J (ORAL)

1. Result of the petitioner for the post of Deputy District Attorney in Prosecution Department in respect of Advertisement No.2/2015 has been produced in sealed cover in Court. The same has been opened. A perusal thereof reveals that petitioner-Vikram Dahiya, who had appeared in the General Category, secured total of 60.80 marks in the selection process as against the final cut off 69.33 marks therefore has not qualified the recruitment test, although he was provisionally interviewed pursuant to order of this Court. Photocopy of the result as forwarded by the Secretary, Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula duly signed by learned counsel for the Commission, is taken on record.

2. On perusal thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the writ petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
