Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 01.06.2019 and all the injuries have been declared simple in nature.

On the other hand, learned counsel for first informant-injured submit that the injured had suffered head injury and the wound had to be stitched with 15 stitches.

Be that as it may. Petitioner is already in custody for merely 4 ½ months. Regular bail application of co-accused Pawan Kumar has been

allowed vide order dated 20.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-39081-2019.

As per custody certificate, he is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for merely 4 ½ months and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
