The writ petition involves the setting up of a Bio Gas Power Project based on cow dung, press mud and poultry litter under Self Identified Category of NRSE Policy, 2012.

Learned senior counsel representing the petitioner-firm submits that after filing of the instant writ petition an unconditional undertaking had been submitted to the Punjab Energy Development Agency and vide communication dated 16.1.2019 received by the petitioner-firm, it has been informed that the case for issue of allotment letter in its favour has been approved.

Learned senior counsel submits that in the light of such development he has instructions not to pursue the instant writ petition.

In the light of such statement made by learned senior counsel, instant writ petition is disposed of as withdrawal.

Suffice it to observe that it would always be open for the petitioner-firm to approach this Court afresh in the eventuality of any order being passed which may be construed as detrimental to its interests.
