Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.29, dated 10.04.2018, registered under Sections 406/420 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner along with other co-accused had cheated the first informant and his family members with a sum of Rs.36,88,000/- on the promise of helping in immigration.

Petitioner has already settled his dispute with the first informant. The affidavit of the first informant has been filed. Counsel appearing for the first informant also reiterate the aforesaid fact.

Keeping in view the aforesaid undisputed facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to direct releasing of the petitioner on bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to

the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
