On 06.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.75, dated 16.07.2019, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that from the reading of the averments made in the FIR, there are no allegations which may constitute offence of abatement of suicide punishable under Section 306 IPC. He further refers to Section 107 of the Indian Penal Code where abatement has been defined.

Notice of motion for 30.10.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Dalwinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 06.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
