Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0093 dated 20.07.2019 under Sections 326, 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kathunangal, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 06.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact, there is a matrimonial dispute between sister of the petitioner and complainant Manjit Singh and in the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C., the complainant is in arrears of Rs.3.00 lacs towards his wife, who is sister of the petitioner. It is further submitted that

there is a delay of 04 days in registration of the FIR and family of the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case, on account of matrimonial discord...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rachhpal Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
