Bimla Devi and others Vs. Rohtash and others

Vide order dated 11.04.2019 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹5,00,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹4,00,000/- and not by ₹5,00,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹4,00,000/- (Rupees Four lacs only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1 Bimla Devi.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹4,00,000/- (Rupees Four lacs only) in the name of the appellant No.1 Bimla Devi wife of Ranvir with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 20.06.2019 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
