Present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the transfer order dated 9/12.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) whereby petitioner has been transferred from Amritsar to Raja Sansi Branch.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents-State Bank of India points out that the present petition has become infructuous, as the petitioner has joined at the place of posting way back on 10.04.2018. Even otherwise, the Branch Raja Sansi where he has been posted is only 10 Kms from Branch where he was earlier posted. He also points out that the Branch office of the State Bank of India at Raja Sansi is within the city limits of Amritsar.

In view thereof, no ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
