B.S. WALIA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned Sr. DAG states that in view of pendency of representations Annexure P/11 dated 29.08.2019 and Annexure P/13 dated 02.09.2019 and interim stay having been granted to the petitioner against transfer vide order dated 06.09.2019, the writ petition be disposed of by granting liberty to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations Annexure P/11 dated 29.08.2019 and Annexure P/13 dated 02.09.2019 in accordance with law in such time as is granted by this Court.

2. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations Annexure P/11 dated 29.08.2019 and Annexure P/13 dated 02.09.2019 in accordance with law as well as policy applicable within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this

order. Till such time that decision is taken on the representations as referred to above, the interim order shall continue to remain in force. However, further action as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case would be subject to the outcome of the decision to be taken by respondent No.2 on the representations as referred to above.

4. Writ petition disposed of in aforementioned terms.
