ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 114 dated 15.05.2019, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of three days in registering the FIR. He also contends that the petitioner is 24 years of age and he himself had received six injuries out of which one was grievous in nature. He has referred to the copy of the MLR of the petitioner at Annexure P5.

This Court, by the order dated 09.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
