[1] At the outset, learned counsel states that the petitioner has served a legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 13.06.2019 on respondent No.3 in respect of the grievance, which is the subject matter of the writ petition but that no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 13.06.2019, in accordance with law.

[3] Mr. Arun Kaundal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3. Copy of the writ petition supplied to the learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab. On perusal of the writ petition, learned Deputy Advocate General states that

he has no objection to the innocuous prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] Accordingly, in the light of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 13.06.2019, in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
