At the outset, learned counsel states that the petitioner has filed a representation Annexure P-5 dated 24.7.2019 before respondent Nos.2 and 3 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-5 dated 24.7.2019 in a time bound manner.

In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-5 dated 24.7.2019 as per rules and regulations applicable as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. Writ petition disposed of with aforementioned directions.
