ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.199 dated 04.07.2019, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that various articles including mobile phone, wallet containing Rs.3,000/- and other documents of the complainant were snatched by the petitioner and the co-accused. He further contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The petitioner is 24 year of age and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, states that 5 out of 10 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 4 months, he is 24 year of age, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
