The only prayer made in this revision petition is that the execution petition pending before the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Batala, be decided expeditiously, since the house in question in which the revisionists are residing is in dilapidated condition and it can fall at any time, which may result in loss of life and property.

Of course expeditious disposal is right of every litigant. A person gets the actual relief when the decree in his favour is executed and delay in the execution proceedings is uncalled for.

Therefore, the revision petition is disposed of with a

direction to the Executing Court to decide the execution petition expeditiously by giving short adjournments, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order in that Court.
