The matter has again been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.4,35,000/- (Rupees Four Lac Thirty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. Counsel for the appellant further states that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Smt. Sudesh W/o Shri Baldev Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.4,35,000/- (Rupees Four Lac Thirty Five Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Smt. Sudesh W/o Shri Baldev Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.02.2020. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
