After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the view that the present petition can be conveniently disposed of on the very first date of hearing.

Petitioner was granted the concession of bail in a criminal case filed through FIR in the year 2016. It has been pleaded that the petitioner has been regularly appearing on each and every date and due to wrong noting of the date, could not appear before the Court on 15.07.2019 when the bail was cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that given an opportunity, petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and

furnish fresh bail bonds and surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

This order is conditional. If the petitioner complies with the same, he shall be released on bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Petitioner shall also be required to file an affidavit that he would not remain absent from the Court except when exemption from personal appearance has been granted in advance.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
