The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.254, dated 05.07.2019, under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 1 kg. 500 grams of ganja has allegedly been recovered from her which is below the threshold of 20 kgs. as commercial quantity. The petitioner is 30 years old lady with two minor children and is in custody for over two months.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner is involved in two other cases under the NDPS Act but the recovery therein is 330 grams and 450 grams of ganja. He also states that challan has been filed but the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is a lady with two minor children, she is in custody for over two months and the conclusion of the trial likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
