This application has been filed by the appellant for preponing the date of hearing of the main appeal in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

In view of the facts and circumstances mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the appeal is taken up for final hearing today itself.

The appellant is present in person whereas the respondents are represented through their counsel.

This appeal has been preferred by the appellant assailing the Judgement and decree dated 15.06.2010 passed in Civil Appeal RT No.161

of 2010. However, vide order dated 26.10.2018 a co-ordinate Bench of this Court referred the appeal for mediation before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Muktsar Sahib. The report of the Mediator is stating that the parties appeared and agreed for settlement. All the parties have joined and signed the document prepared by the Mediator which is dated 24.01.2019.

The appellant is personally present and he submits that he has accepted the settlement and so is stated by learned counsel who is appearing for the respondents.

Accordingly, this appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement reached between the parties before the Mediator, Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Sri Muktsar Sahib, which would form part of the decree.

Accordingly, the Judgements and decrees of the Courts below are set aside.
